Items of Importance

- **\$ave to be Brave:** Start putting money away for the possibility of future labour action. Don't be caught unprepared.
- Complaint: If you or colleagues are subject to a complaint filed with the Alberta Teaching Profession Commission, contact Regulatory Affairs at the Association as soon as possible.
- CPP & EI: Teachers will notice CPP and EI contribution deductions again on their paycheques. With the new CPP structures in place, there will be a larger increase in CPP deductions. CPP will become a large part of teachers' retirement income. More information can be found using the QR code.
- Violence: A teacher who suffers harm should immediately report the incident to the principal; document the incident within the school; seek medical intervention where necessary; consider whether the student's placement and programming are appropriate; engage the school, the division and the parents; and consider whether authorities (such as the police or child welfare) should be involved.
